

## Google PhD Fellowship

### **Award**

This fellowship provides 2 years of tuition and stipend to support PhD students pursuing Google's defined areas of research interest. The current stipend is \$35,000.

Google strongly encourages applicants with diverse backgrounds to apply to this fellowship, especially those from historically marginalized groups in the field of computing.

### **Internal Deadline:**

Friday, April 12, 2024 at 5pm

#### Materials due:

- Complete application
- 1 letter of recommendation from dissertation advisor

### **Recommender Deadline:**

Friday, May 3, 2024 at 5pm

#### Materials due:

- Final application
- 2 remaining letters of recommendation

### **External Deadline:**

Wednesday, May 8, 2024

### **Eligibility**

- Students must remain enrolled full-time in the PhD program for the duration of the Fellowship or forfeit the award.
- Students must have completed graduate coursework by the start of the academic year during which the fellowship begins.
- Google employees, and their spouses, children, and members of their household are not eligible.
- Students that are already supported by a comparable industry award are not eligible. Government or non-profit organization funding is exempt.

## **APPLICATION PROCESS**

The university is limited to **four** nominations each year.

### **INTERNAL DEADLINE**

Students must submit completed applications as a single document to Kevin Doherty in UChicagoGRAD ([kevdoh@uchicago.edu](mailto:kevdoh@uchicago.edu)) by the internal deadline.

Only one letter of recommendation from the student's dissertation advisor is due at the internal deadline. Letters of recommendation should be submitted by letter writers directly to Kevin Doherty ([kevdoh@uchicago.edu](mailto:kevdoh@uchicago.edu)).

### **INTERNAL REVIEW**

A committee comprised of faculty from eligible divisions will review all submitted nominations.

### **POST REVIEW**

Students who are selected as nominees will be notified of their status. At this time, we will ask them to notify their second and third letter writers that they have been selected as nominees for the Google PhD Fellowship.

The final two letters of recommendation must be submitted to Kevin Doherty ([kevdoh@uchicago.edu](mailto:kevdoh@uchicago.edu)) no later than Friday, May 3, 2024.

### **FINAL SUBMISSION**

The fellowships team in UChicagoGRAD will submit final applications to Google on behalf of students.

## **APPLICATION COMPONENTS**

**(Subject to change)**

1. Cover Sheet (see following page for sample)
2. Student CV with links to personal website and publications
3. Advisor CV, 1-page maximum
4. 3 Letters of Recommendation, including one from dissertation advisor
  - a. Only the letter from the dissertation advisor is due at the internal deadline
  - b. The cover sheet must confirm the names of the second and third recommenders, and confirm they have agreed to write letters if asked
5. Research / dissertation proposal (3 page limit, excluding references)
6. Research Impact student essay (350-word limit) to:

Describe the desired impact your research will make on the field and society, and why this is important to you. Include any personal, educational and/or professional experiences that have motivated your research interests.
7. Leadership student essay (350-word limit) to:

Describe an example of your leadership experience in which you have positively influenced others, helped resolve disputes or contributed to group efforts over time. (A leadership role can mean more than just a title. It can mean being a mentor to others, acting as the person in charge of a specific task, or taking the lead role in organizing an event or project. Think about what you accomplished and what you learned from the experience. What were your responsibilities? Did you lead a team? How did your experience change your perspective on leading others? Did you help to resolve an important dispute at your school, church, in your community or an organization? And your leadership role doesn't necessarily have to be limited to school activities. For example, do you help out or take care of your family?)
8. Transcripts of current and previous academic records (Official preferred; unofficial accepted)
